SEEDED BERMUDA ESTABLISHMENT PROGRAM

1. Spray Roundup Pro at 2 qts per acre; if broadleaves are present in existing turf add a good post emergent like Millenium @ 3 pts per acre. This application must be done 3 – 4 weeks previous to seeding – Mid April to May 10th.
2. Seed with Improved Bermuda Variety at 2 lbs per 1000 sq ft.
3. Fertilize with Mears 10-24-18 at 300 lbs per acre at seeding time.

Once Bermuda is up, fertilize with Custom 20-10-10 with A.S. at 5 bags per **acre on three (3) week intervals until August 15th.**

Once Bermuda is up and has been mowed twice, if soft crabgrass has germinated in fairways, spray with Drive or One Time.

4. If goosegrass is present spray with Illoxan, or Sencor, rates to be discussed.
5. If broadleaves become a problem, spray Millenium or something friendly to Bermuda at 2 pts. per acre.
6. If an area to be seeded the next summer is expected to be a broadleaf problem area, you may want to treat the area with Gallery DF at 1 lb per acre in Nov.-Feb. to prevent broadleaves from germinating.
7. Area may need to be treated for grubs in August with one of several products available.



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Fertilize with a good Potassium based product sometime in Sept. or very early In October for winter hardiness. .

Try to keep golf cart traffic off any newly seeded Bermuda at least its first winter. **And finally,**

**Quit mowing your Bermuda in early Sept. so it can get at least
One and a half to two inches tall before it goes into winter
Dormancy.**
