ZOYSIA OR BERMUDA SPRIGGING OR STRIP SODDING ESTABLISHMENT

Apply RegalStar at four (4) to five (5) bags per acre during normal pre-emerge time, April 1st approximately. You could delay this right up to the time you sprig.

One to two days before sprigging apply Primo Maxx at 1 quart per acre or Chipco Proxy at 7 quarts per acre. This will slow down existing grasses for about 30 days allowing the Zoysia or Bermuda sprigs to get a start.

Water frequently, but no need to flood it.

Apply Acelepryn, Merit or Mach 2 approximately June 15 for season-long grub control.

Fertilize every two to three weeks. Apply STP Custom 20-10-10 with 45% Ammonium Sulfate at five (5) bags per acre, alternating every other time with Anderson's Starter 14-28-10- at four (4) bags per acre, or a Starter like 10-24-18 w/50% Umaxx, SOP at four (4) bags per acre. If you begin around June 10 you should get approximately a total of 5 applications per season.

Make your final application of starter fertilizer sometime in September.

NOTE: If you missed your spring application of pre-emerge, then post emergently clean up your crabgrass and apply RegalStar about one week before your sprigging begins. **FAILURE** to apply your pre-emerge will result in excessive crab and goose grass because of the extra watering.

This program is for sprigging into existing turf.



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For optimum results, spray out entire area with RoundUp Pro for a total kill of all existing grasses. This will eliminate all competition and give the advantage to the Zoysia or Bermuda.

This would also eliminate the need to spray Primo or Proxy as a growth regulator..
