BERMUDA OVERWINTERING TIPS

It's only been a few short months ago that we survived last winter. Most of the Bermuda in our area did not.

We are unable to provide you with any hard scientific data; however, we have observed some very interesting results from the use of "**PRIMO**". This spring there was a drastic difference on spring green up and survival rate of "**PRIMO**" plots vs. non treated.

Dr. Joe DiPalo from CIBA and I have had conversations regarding the results. We believe that two things are actually happening. First off, the obvious: The carbohydrate reserve is better because of **Primo**. Secondly, we believe that there is an added benefit of the **Primo** not allowing the plant to dry out so much, thereby preventing winter dehydration.

Here are two simple suggestions.

Begin September 1; spray **Primo** WSB @ 5-1/2 oz per acre. Repeat this every three weeks as long as the Bermuda is growing. You should get two or maybe three sprays yet this fall.

Sometime in late September apply Lange Proline 10-24-18 at six bags per acre. This will give you 2 lbs of Phosphate and 1 lb of Potassium going into dormancy.

I'm confident that the results next spring will be well worth your time and investment.
