TURF TIPS FOR THE WINTER

Dear Superintendent:

Most everyone can think back not many months ago and remember wind-chill factors of 50 to 60 degrees below zero without snow cover.

The following ideas are ones that you already know; however, often times we forget to implement our own ideas until someone reminds us. Here is your reminder:

1. Apply potash to greens and tees to aid in winter hardiness.
2. Possibly cover short mowed tees, especially ones that are subject to harsh winds.
3. For those of you that have a knotweed problem, apply Dacthal 6F at 2 gallons per acre or Gallery at 1 lb. per acre prior to the ground freezing.
4. Also, remember late fall and early winter are excellent times to apply Par Ex w/IBDU. Let IBDU work on your turf this winter. It feeds and develops new roots after U.F. types stop. You will be well pleased with the results next spring.
5. Why not try some Nutriculture soluble N, P, K to help store some of the Essential nutrients in the plant tissue. Just mix it right in with your last application for snow mold control. I would suggest either 10-20-30 or 13-0-44 at 1 lb material per 1,000 sq ft.
6. The most effective fungicide today for Pink or Gray snow mold still Remains to be Mercury. Use Calo Clor at 5 lbs per acre or Calo Gran at 6 lbs per 1,000 sq ft.
7. Finally, how about putting in two cups for pin rotation before the ground freezes and you can't.
